Joint Efforts in Promoting Child Passenger Safety

Background: Partnership started in 2017 from established work together around pedestrian safety

Results: Collaborated with various law enforcement groups to conduct car seat certification courses, classes, and check events

- Certified 3 officers and 10 instructors, 4 officer taught classes, and 3-4 joint check events annually

Impact: Enhanced relationship between community and law enforcement , Increased pool of technicians and instructors to address CPS in different communities, Sustainable partnerships to assist in other Injury Prevention efforts

Advocacy on Child Restraint Usage into National Law

Minyan(Monica)Cui*¹, Chunyan(Amidy) Peng^{1,1} Safe Kids China, China

Background: Child passengers account for over 30% of child road traffic crash deaths in China, but child restraint usage is not in the national law before 2021.

Objective/Method: Aiming to have child restraint usage into the national law, our advocacy work focusing on:

- Policy influencers by providing them fact and information through seminars
- Public awareness during the critical time
- Technical support to policy executor and parents

Results:

- New National Minor Protection Law (NML) [June 2021],
- New Chinese Children Development Outline (CDO) [September 2021]
